

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT CAMP

Detailed class supply lists: All supply lists are available online at www.campwatchapatcher.org. Go to the Classes tab, select your class and you will see the "Supply List".

Vanguard: A typical college campus. While compact and FLAT it does require walking between classrooms, dining hall and dorms. All classrooms are on the first floor and are handicap accessible. Elevators are available to upper floor dorm rooms.

Parking: Please park only in the designated areas – signs will mark Vanguard parking. Vanguard is located next door to Costa Mesa City Hall & Police Department **DO NOT** park in the City lot – you will be ticketed or towed as these are clearly marked. Those attending only evening programs – please park in the Church parking lot at the corner of Fair/Newport (see directions and location on the website).

Golf Carts: A limited number of golf carts will be available for those who may need assistance. Please note – given the compact campus and flat terrain we request these be reserved for those who have a physical need.

Classrooms: Each classroom will have one ironing station, extension cord hubs, tables and chairs. You will need to bring a power strip and /or extension cord for classes requiring a machine. Please use ONLY BLUE Painters Masking Tape if you are hanging items in the class. NO PINS allowed. Classrooms will open at 8:30 am and all Classes will start promptly at 9:00am.

Classes: Bring items as required on your class selection supply lists. Basic sewing machine, cleaned, oiled & ready! Appropriate feet, bobbins, replacement needles, extension cord and power strip. Basic quilting supplies: Thread, needles, scissors, pins, marking pencils, seam ripper, cutting mat, rotary cutter, replacement blades, ruler, flannel for a design wall, iron, ironing pad, glue stick, light and of course chocolate for that energy boost!

Dorm rooms: Each resident will have a twin bed, dresser, and desk. Linens, pillow and towels will be supplied. All rooms are two people per room, unless you have selected a private room. We suggest you bring some creature comforts from home, such as a quilt for your bed, **lighting**, bath mat, extension cord, fan (if you are in a non-a/c room), alarm clock, and snacks. Dorm rooms **DO NOT** have a mini-fridge or a microwave. We suggest you bring a small ice chest if you wish to have chilled items (ice will be available in the Dining Hall).

Dorm Check In/Out: Check In will be on Sunday in the Catalina Dorm Lounge from 12-4pm. Check In for Tues/Wed will be in The Cove from 4-5pm. Check Out on Tuesday is from 12-1pm, turn in Keys in The Cove, Check out on Thursday is 4-5:30, turn in Keys in the Catalina Lounge. Check out Friday is from 9-11, turn in keys in the Catalina Lounge.

Registration Check In: Will be open Mon-Thurs at 8am at The Cove. Please give yourself plenty of time to check in and get to your class. Day Campers and Part time Residents may also pickup your Registration packet on Sun from 12-4pm in the Catalina Lounge.

Evening Programs: All evening programs shall be held in the Quilters Pavilion. The doors will open at 6:45 pm and the program will start at 7:00pm. Special Event only Campers should park in the lot on the corner of Fair Dr/Newport Blvd.

Medical Information/Prescriptions: In case of sudden illness or injury please have your proof of insurance. Bring any prescription medicines you take on a regular basis (check and double check that you have these!). If you become ill we are required to notify your emergency contact.

Classroom Etiquette: Please turn off the sound on your cell phone. Be on time and ready to go. If you are late, please enter quietly and try to catch up. Bring all mandatory items on the supply list. If you wish to deviate from the class project, do not expect the teacher to take time from the rest of the class to accommodate you. If the class is not what you expected, remain in class and give it a fair chance. You may just learn something you weren't expecting! Please check with the teacher before sharing handouts from the workshop - individual teachers have varying policies on how their designs can be used.

Internet Access: Dorm rooms have wireless internet access available. We suggest you bring an Ethernet cable in case you need to plug in verses using the wireless service.
