We are fiber artists, why not wear our art. Create an original vest or jacket using the quilting skills you already own. Starting with a simple pattern we will make a muslin base to insure a perfect fit then using your favorite colors make a vest or jacket you will wear every day.

Pattern Suggestions: Very Easy Vogue, Burda, Lois Erickson, Rosemary Eichorn or other designer patterns, the fewer seams the better.

Fabric Requirements: Select a focus fabric along with blenders and solids. This is the ideal class to use that special airbrush dragon or special fabric you purchased on vacation or at the last quilt show.
Suggestions: Geometric prints, novelty prints, batiks, and variety of value and scale. Bring lots of fun fabric as idea starters.

3 yards of foundation fabric, this fabric will not show. A lightweight muslin works well.

Sewing Supplies: Sewing machine in good working order (bring manual)
Microtex sharp needles 80/12
Topstitch needles 90/14
Thread to match fabric
Decorative threads for threadplay
Extra bobbins wound
Rotary cutter and mat
Fabric scissors
Glass head pins (2 boxes if you plan to collage)
Marking pencils or pens
Notebook and pencils (include colored pencils to play with design)
