

Class # 113 – Mariner’s Medallion Monday



The Mariner’s Medallion Wallhanging

Finished quilt: 38” x 38”

The Mariner’s Medallion Wallhanging is the perfect size quilt for your home or office and makes a wonderful first-time foundation-piecing project. The compass goes together quickly and is finished with a simple, traditionally pieced border of Flying Geese, a narrow accent border, and a wider outer border.

Make this little quilt to commemorate an event, trip, holiday, season, or favorite fabric!

This Materials list is for the wallhanging on page 44 of my book; ***M'Liss Rae Hawley Mariner's Medallion Quilts***. Please follow the directions for Materials according to the quilt you select to make from the book.

The fabric requirements are a guide, the more you bring the more fun and creativity! I'll assist with your fabric placement!

Materials

All yardage is based on fabric 40"-wide after laundering.

- 1/3 yard *each* of 5 (this is the minimum) different fabrics for the center and points
- 2/3 yard for the Mariner’s Compass block background square
- 1/2 yard *each* of 2 contrasting fabrics for the Flying Geese border (Fabric 1 and Fabric 2)
- 1/4 yard for the accent border
- 2/3 yard for the outer border
- 1/2 yard for the binding
- 2 5/8 yards for the backing
- 46” x 46” piece of batting

Additional Supplies

- A sewing machine in good working order
- 100% cotton thread for piecing
- Fine head pins with glass heads
- Scissors; fabric and paper, and a seam ripper
- Rotary equipment: cutter, cutting mat, & rulers
- 10 copies of the 16 1/2" wedge on page 73
