Master Crazy Quilting! Create a handbag while learning the technique of crazy quilting. Melody will guide you in the creative use of fabric, buttons, threads, beads and fancy stitches. Learn easy ways to make a bow, how to create texture with ribbons and lace and to make folded ribbon roses.



Supply List

Finished size approximately (closed) 5½" X 7".

Fabric for the crazy patch: Choose a variety of colors or just one, be sure that you have a variety of textures. Remember that your stitches show better on plainer fabrics.

For one 12" block or small bag: fifteen to twenty five 4" by 10" strips
13" X 13" piece of muslin

Embellishments

(You do not need to bring all of the following, but remember 'variety is the spice of life')

Embroidery floss, silk button hole twist, metallic thread - assorted colors

Beads

Nymo thread (beading thread)

Buttons

Brass charms

Ribbon - scraps - 1/16" wide to 1" wide

- satin
- textured
- picot-edged
- velvet
- grosgrain

Silk Ribbon - assorted colors

Lace or lace motifs

Notions

Basic sewing supplies (scissors, needles, thread, etc.)

Embroidery needles

Chenille needles (for silk ribbon work)

Marking pen or pencil (appropriate color)

Sewing machine and extension cord

Materials required to complete Purse (not necessary for class or to make block)

10" X 35" piece of iron-on interfacing

10" X 25" piece of fleece, **or** warm & natural **or** thermolamb

10" X 35" piece of fancy fabric for lining (a heavier fabric is better)

Buttons - two ½" flat and one ½" ball or shank button

6"X9" mm pony beads **or** glass pebble beads

3 yds each 4 or 5 assorted colors and sizes of cording
