DESIGNING ART QUILTS – Student Supply List for 2-day class

- ❖ Photographs or drawings – (your own, to avoid copyright issues) – I recommend a range of photos to work with, as you may work with several, or a combination. Good quality, clear photos are easiest to work with. Any subject matter that interests you is fine – it's especially fun to work with a photo that has meaning for you.
- ❖ Photograph of a face, if your project does not feature a close-up of one.
- ❖ 8 ½" x 11" photocopies (black and white are fine) of photos, **or computer printouts (color) in a similar size, if original photos are smaller.** Our exercises in shading will be best with a face that is at least 3-4 inches high, so the photocopies or digital prints of that size are for enlarging purposes, if needed. Bring originals for reference.
- ❖ Pencil and computer paper for exercises (or sketchpad if preferred)
- ❖ Sharpie ultrafine tip marker
- ❖ Lightbox (students may share – at least 4 in room is best)
- ❖ **Fabrics: Note enclosed instructions for Dot Test (fabric bleedability)**
- ❖ Non-bleed muslin (see Dot Test paper) pressed to freezer paper: at least 3 sheets of 8 ½" x 11"
- ❖ Extra fabrics: if desired, bring similar sized pieces of skin tone fabrics for faces, or other fabrics that suit your intended project for inking work.
- ❖ **Student Supply Fee: \$15 included in class fee**
- ❖ Textile Inks: we will be working a great deal with the Tsukineko All Purpose Inks, with the Fantastix applicators, as well as the Fabrico Textile Markers made by the same company. It isn't necessary, as I bring class inks to share, but many people wish to purchase their own, as they are such fun to use. If you wish to purchase any of these supplies check your local shop or visit www.jukeboxquilts.com, which sells these products mail-order, and you can bring them to class.
