

Oopsie Daisy Supply List – Darlene Zimmerman

This is a whimsical pattern that incorporates both piecing and appliqué in a wall-hanging, twin or queen size quilt—your choice! Easy strip piecing is used for the pieced blocks, and several methods of appliqué will be taught—you can choose fusible, freezer paper or needle-turn methods.

Supplies

Pattern for *Oopsie Daisy* found in quilt shops or www.feedsacklady.com

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
General sewing supplies
Sewing machine
Iron (unless supplied for the classroom)

Cheap paper plates
*Easy Angle

*Companion Angle (alternate cutting directions are given if you choose not to use the tools)

Freezer paper, template plastic, bias bars, fusible webbing (Bring whichever supplies for the method of appliqué you prefer.)

Fabrics for the size quilt you have chosen—see pattern.

Please pre-cut the fabric strips following the pattern instructions before class. If cutting Companion or Easy Angle triangles, please read package directions!

Note: I will be bringing my Bias Tape machine to class to make bias stems. Please do NOT pre-cut your bias strips for stems.
