

**CONTEMPORARY ART QUILTING
SUPPLY LIST
INSTRUCTOR: CHARLOTTE ROGERS**

If you are a traditional quilter and would like to move into art quilting but fusing makes you uncomfortable, this is the class for you. Working with curves and circles, all pieced, you will create a work of art. This is a technique class to give you a base for future art work.

Fabric Requirements:

- 10-12 1/2 yard pieces of fabric that read solid in light, medium and dark. Batiks, hand dyes and blenders work very well for this technique. If you have a focus fabric you would like to play with, bring it. Choose colors that you love.
- Batting to use as a design wall

Basic Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order (bring guide book)
- Extra bobbins
- Piecing thread
- Large cutting mat (12 X 18) or larger
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Iron
- Small ironing pad if you have one
- Spray Bottle for water

Journal or Idea Book: If you use a journal or idea book to document your quilting journey please bring it. If you have not started an idea book now is the time. Pick up an inexpensive journal and bring it to class.
